To fund a global harvest of souls, empowering every believer to take part in fulfilling the Great Commission.

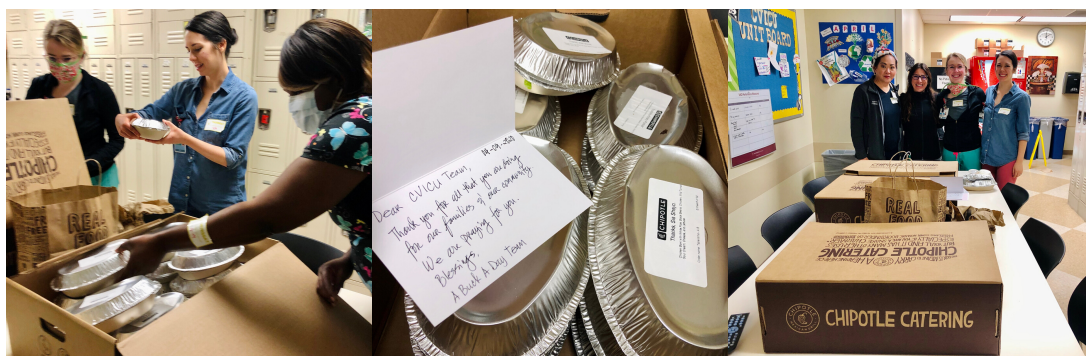
## **Mission**
